

Counselor Education Faculty: Open Rank

ADLER UNIVERSITY is seeking qualified candidates to fill a full time, open rank, core faculty position for its recently instituted Ph.D. Program in Counselor Education and Supervision. The position begins in January 2018 or sooner. The position includes faculty rank, and summer teaching is available.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates are required to have a doctorate in Counselor Education and Supervision, preferably from a CACREP accredited program. We are looking for candidates with experience in teaching, research, supervision, clinical practice, and eligibility for Illinois counselor licensure.

PREFERENCE will be given to those possessing expertise in research design and quantitative and qualitative methodologies, along with knowledge of advanced clinical approaches and procedures. In addition, candidates should be able to demonstrate competence in, or clear potential for, scholarly activity such as publishing and presenting.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Duties include teaching at the doctoral level, advising and mentoring doctoral students, participation in institutional and departmental committees, dissertation committees, and making admissions decisions, along with support of department and institutional initiatives. Candidates must be willing to align with the University's mission and values which is training socially responsible practitioners, engaging communities, advancing social justice, and freedom and liberation from oppression. This position requires the teaching of evening and weekend in-classroom courses, including some blended courses. Candidates are also expected to demonstrate excellent communication and interpersonal skills, and an ability to collaborate effectively with students, faculty, and professional staff and associates.

APPLICATION PROCESS: Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position has been filled.
