Department of Psychology and Counseling:

Clinical Mental Health Counseling Tenure-Track Position: Assistant Professor, Counselor Education, Jonesboro, Arkansas. This is a 9-month, full-time, tenure track position with opportunity for additional summer contract. The position begins August of 2018.

Program Description:

The Ed.S in Clinical Mental Health Counseling is a 60 credit hour full time/part time program of study. We are currently seeking CACREP accreditation, and, our courses are aligned with CACREP accreditation standards. Graduates typically are employed in community mental health centers or others social service agencies. Students complete practicum and internships in settings related to their career goals. Coursework prepares students for state licensure as a Licensed Associate Counselor in Arkansas and certification as a National Certified Counselor. Program requirements include successful completion of a Comprehensive Exam (Counselor Preparation Comprehensive Examination and an essay response to a case study scenario). Students also have the option to complete a thesis if desired. Our program also houses two graduate certificate programs in Clinical Mental Health Counseling and Play Therapy for students who are currently enrolled or who already possess a masters degree or higher in counseling or a related mental health field.

Position Description: The successful candidate will have a demonstrated record of excellence in teaching; significant experience teaching graduate courses; training and experience conducting clinical supervision; and, a clear research agenda and potential for publication in key professional journals in the field. This individual will also be required to teach undergraduate courses within the Counseling Minor. Eligibility for licensure as a Counselor in the state of Arkansas and/or national certification as a Counselor (NCC) is also required. The successful candidate will demonstrate strong cultural competence, verbal communication and interpersonal skills necessary for effective collaboration with a diverse community of students, faculty, staff, and external constituents.

Required Qualifications:

- A doctorate (Ph.D., Ed.D.) in Counselor Education with an emphasis in Clinical Mental Health Counseling (ABDs will be considered, pending timeline for degree completion).
- Evidence of teaching in graduate courses.
- Evidence of an established research agenda.
- Participation in regional, national, and/or international professional associations.
- Evidence of professional counseling experience.

Preferred Qualifications:

- A doctorate from a CACREP-accredited program.
- Evidence of ability to develop, teach, and assess student performance.
- Evidence of teaching in undergraduate courses.

Other Information:

- Please include a vitae, official transcripts, a statement of research interests and accomplishments, a statement of teaching philosophy, and three (3) letters of recommendation submitted directly by letter writers.
- Opportunity for additional summer contract work.
- A doctorate from a CACREP-accredited program, evidence of ability to develop, teach, and assess student performance, and teaching in undergraduate courses are preferred.
