

Tenure Track Associate Professor (Full Professor considered) Position Available

Position: Associate Professor (Full Professor will be considered), and Director of CACREP Accredited Master's Program in Clinical Mental Health Counseling. Tenure-line faculty position available August 21, 2018 in the Department of Counseling Psychology, Social Psychology and Counseling at Ball State University, Muncie Indiana.

Position Description: Highly qualified scholar within counselor education to direct CACREP accredited program in clinical mental health counseling and teach courses in the undergraduate and graduate programs in the Department of Counseling Psychology, Social Psychology and Counseling.

Minimum Qualifications: Doctorate in counselor education from a CACREP accredited doctoral program. The candidate should demonstrate professional competence in a specialty area within the field of counselor education.

Preferred Qualifications: Licensed as a Mental Health Counselor in the State of Indiana. Special consideration will be given to candidates who can also contribute to other graduate programs within the department. Applicants should be able to mentor students on diversity issues and facilitate immersive learning experiences. Prior experience teaching in a CACREP accredited program.

Certifications/Licensures: Licensed within first three years as a Mental Health Counselor in the State of Indiana.

Pre-Employment Screening: Requires successful completion of a background check.

The faculty members involved with these programs have extensive experience in ACA (e.g., Chairs of ACA and AMHCA Licensure Committees, Editor of *JMHC*, Co-Editor of *Journal for Social Action in Counseling & Psychology*, Editorial Board of *JCD*, *JMHC*, *CES*, and *CDQ*) and are recipients of ACA and AMHCA national awards.
