Job Description and Responsibilities:

- At least two years of graduate teaching experience in a university setting
- At least five years of clinical and/or administrative experience
- Experience teaching research courses and supervising doctoral students is desired
- Must have an established program of scholarship in area of teaching and practice
- Must have demonstrated commitment to diversity and social justice
- Must hold a clinical license or be license-eligible
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Must be authorized to work in the United States

Preferred Qualifications:

Experience teaching research courses and supervising doctoral students.
