Tenure-track Position in Counselor Education Specialization in School Counseling

New Jersey City University, Department of Counselor Education invites applications for a full-time tenure-track faculty position for our CACREP Accredited School Counseling Program at the Assistant or Associate faculty level starting September 1st, 2018.

Interested applicants should have an earned doctorate in counselor education and supervision and New Jersey School Counselor Certification or eligibility. Additionally, a New Jersey counselor licensure (LAC or LPC) or eligibility is preferred. Applicants should possess school counselor experience, knowledge of the American School Counseling Association (ASCA) model, a demonstrated knowledge and commitment to CACREP accreditation and willing to prepare students to work in urban and diverse populated school settings. Successful applicants will be required to teach graduate counseling courses, participate in departmental and university activities, advisement, become affiliated with professional counseling organizations, and engage in research and scholarly activities.

Candidates with a counselor education and supervision doctorate from a CACREP accredited program are preferred. Specialization in school is required. Counseling research and contributions to scholarly counseling publications will be highly valued. Candidates are expected to have the ability to work collaboratively with other faculty members within and outside of the department.

Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled.
