The Department of Counseling and Educational Psychology is seeking applicants for an Assistant /Associate Professor, **tenure track position** starting in August 2018. The department offers masters' level programs in clinical mental health counseling; marriage, couple, and family counseling; school counseling; addictions counseling; and a doctoral program in Counselor Education. All programs are CACREP-accredited. The Department, with a vibrant productive faculty, serves a significant number of students and was named recipient of the 2007 **ACES Robert Frank Outstanding Counselor Education Program Award**.

Position Description: Assistant/Associate Professor in Counseling (with an emphasis in clinical mental health counseling)

Required Qualifications: (1) a doctorate in counselor education preferably from a CACREP-accredited program (2) expertise in clinical mental health counseling, (3) Professional Counselor Licensure or eligible at time of employment, (4) an identified research agenda, and (5) qualifications to teach, supervise, and advise counseling students.

Preferred Qualifications: (1) paid work experience as a mental health counselor, (2) prior teaching experience in higher education including teaching assistantships (3) utilization of technology and distance learning, (4) membership and involvement in professional counseling organizations, and (5) professional experience working with addictions.
