Position Summary:

We are searching for faculty members to join our Clinical Mental Health Counseling (CMHC) program at our Washington, DC Campus to fill full-time, core faculty positions at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor. The primary instructional assignment for this position is with the CMHC master's program with occasional courses for the doctoral program in Counselor Education & Supervision (CES). This program is designed to meet CACREP standards to prepare graduates to be licensed professional counselors. The primary areas of specialization beyond the counseling core are the treatment of addiction disorders, trauma, child and adolescent treatment, and marriage and family therapy.

- Teach 18 credit hours spread throughout the academic year (fall, spring, & summer) across the core curriculum.
- Student advisement
- Service to the department, the school, and the community
- Participate in faculty development
- Engage in research, publication, and other scholarly activities
