The School of Counseling, Human Performance and Rehabilitation at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock invites applications for a tenure-track, nine (9) month academic position at the Assistant Professor – Counseling Education (R97490) rank. This position will include serving as graduate program coordinator.

The school particularly invites and encourages applications from members of underrepresented groups. Salary is competitive and commensurate with qualifications. We seek faculty who are committed to teaching, research, scholarly publication, and public service. This position is governed by state and federal laws, and agency/institution policy. The deadline for applications is October 1 2017. The starting date is spring (prefer) or fall Semester, 2018.

Minimum Qualifications: A Doctorate from a regionally accredited university in Counselor Education and Supervision or closely related degree from a CACREP-accredited program; must be eligible for school counseling and/or Licensed Professional Counselor credentials in Arkansas and have successful online teaching experience or a commitment to learn effective online instruction.

Preferred Qualifications: A Doctorate from a CACREP accredited program; membership in ACA and ACES; experience with ethnically and culturally diverse populations; experience in school counseling (K-12) and familiarity with CACREP standards is strongly preferred.

This position is subject to a pre-employment criminal and financial history background check. A criminal conviction or arrest pending adjudication alone shall not disqualify an applicant in the absence of a relationship to the requirements of the position. Background check information will be used in a confidential, non-discriminatory manner consistent with state and federal law.
